NAB Delhi's Sparsh: Success Story

Born in Uttar Pradesh, **Shakul Raj Sonker** defied societal prejudice and educational barriers to become India's first blind mathematics graduate. Rejected by schools and universities, he persevered, earning a degree from Ashoka University. He co-founded I-Stem, impacting 15,000+ people with disabilities through technology, education, and employment. Recognized by Microsoft, UNICEF, and National Geographic, he collaborates with global organizations to advance accessibility. NAB Delhi played a key role in his journey, providing hostel support and academic guidance during his high school years. Today, Shakul continues to drive accessibility and inclusion on global platforms.
