Reshma from South West Delhi was born with low vision and later identified with bilateral hearing loss due to complications at birth. Her early years were marked by frequent visits to hospitals.

Her journey took a positive turn when she joined National Association for the Blind Delhi in 2014, where she began receiving structured and individualized intervention.

Today, Reshma can communicate using sign language, write simple words, perform basic counting, and use a computer for typing. She is a cheerful, social learner who loves dancing and exploring new things. With the constant support of her family and dedicated training, Reshma continues to grow in confidence and independence.
