

Disability Sensitization Program at Clifford Chance





NAB Delhi's Sparsh: Success Story – NAZIA AKHTAR



Coming from a modest family in Jammu & Kashmir, Nazia Akhtar faced many hurdles in her education due to her visual impairment and limited resources. Yet, her quiet determination kept her moving forward.

After Class 12, she joined NAB Delhi's computer course at R.K. Puram—a decision that changed her life. With the guidance of trainers, she mastered computers, Microsoft Office, English communication, and NVDA screen reader. Soft skills sessions helped her shed her shyness and gain confidence.

Today, Nazia prepares her own assignments, faces interviews with pride, and stands strong as an independent young woman. Her journey is not just about learning computers but about breaking barriers and discovering her true potential.
