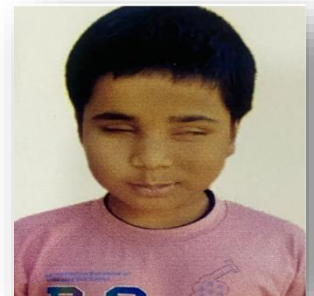

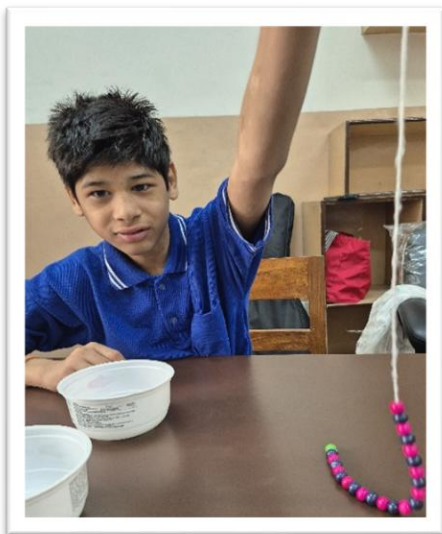
Workshop Session
