

Cooking Without Looking Workshop



Veena Mehta Verma, Director, NAB Delhi (Dwarka Branch), led an inspiring 2-day workshop, "Cooking Without Looking", held from 14-15 June at the Institute for the Blind, Chandigarh. Organized by Positive Abilities Rotaract Club in collaboration with NAB Delhi, Rotary Chandigarh Shivalik, and Institute for the Blind, the workshop trained visually impaired participants in adaptive kitchen skills and sensory-based cooking.

STEM Workshop with uDot



NAB Delhi partnered with uDot for a groundbreaking 5-day STEM workshop. Six students from Grades 6 to 10 explored topics like lines, angles, optics, and geometry using uDot’s refreshable tactile display. The hands-on sessions enabled independent, interactive learning—complete with tactile games—bringing concepts to life for visually impaired learners in a way traditionally reserved for sighted peers.


